With over a mile of frontage on the Great Pee Dee River, significant frontage on Muddy Creek, an oxbow lake, and extensive bottomland hardwood and cypress-tupelo forests, the Tilghman Tract boasts significant wildlife habitat and water resources that are now protected through enhanced forested buffers.

This lower tract of Cattails Tree Farm was permanently protected in 2015.
